# **DEPARTMENT – BUILDING EXHIBITS**

### **SECTION - 4-H DISPLAY/BANNER**

## (Not State Fair Eligible)

### SPECIAL RULES

- 1. Read General Rules. Be especially aware of copyright and trademark rules. Violation of any of the following rules may result in disqualification. All decisions will be made by a county agent and their decision is final.
- 2. This department is open to *any* properly enrolled 4-H member and/or 4-H club.
- 3. One of the intended purposes of this department is to encourage 4-Her involvement with the design and construction of a display and/or banner.
- 4. Each club may enter only one display in this department; however, each club may enter one banner per section (maximum of 2 total club banners).
- 5. Individual 4-H members may also enter one banner per section.
- 6. Each 4-H promotional banner and/or display should illustrate a phase of 4-H work which is being practiced by youth in 4-H or promotes 4-H in general.
- 7. The top three displays and/or banners promoting environmental protection will be awarded special premiums from the Leavenworth County Soil Conservation District.
- 8. Banners are a two dimensional display, depicting one idea. Banner dimensions are to be no less than 12 and no more than 16 square feet, with no side less than 3 feet. Banners must be hung on a rod and rope or hanging wire, strong enough to support the banner. 3-D objects may not be attached to the front of the banner. Attach a label to the back lower left-hand corner of the banner giving the club or member's name, county and year. Letters should be large enough to be viewed from at least 10 feet away. Waterproof ink prevents smearing and is recommended for the label.
- 9. Displays must be freestanding, sturdy and limited to the size of a square card table. If a club display, the club name should appear in a prominent place on the display. Individual member entries should have name in a corner of display. Everything must be contained on the card table including title and display board.
- 10. Each exhibitor will be required to maintain its display exhibit in a clean and orderly manner daily. No perishable items are to be used in display. Take care to select materials that will withstand Fair conditions. If displays are allowed to deteriorate after judging has taken place, ribbon placing may be lowered.
